HOME ARTS EXHIBITS
General Rules and Regulations

- A. All classes are open to non-professional men and women.
- B. Youth Division - all categories open to youth 18 years of age and under.
- C. Entry form can be mailed in by July 1, 2017 to:
Cumberland County Fair Association
P.O. Box 1423
Millville, NJ 08332
- Entries will be accepted on the day of drop off with a completed entry form.
- D. No entry fees will be charged.
- E. Every reasonable precaution is taken to protect entries while at the Fairgrounds, but all entries are at the risk of the exhibitor.
- F. One entry per class.
- G. Each exhibit must be in the quantity and number as required.
- H. Judges' decisions are final. Each entry is judged on its own merit.
- I. One Best of Show, First Premium, Second Premium, and Third Premium will be awarded for each division. All others will receive a Participant ribbon.
- Premiums will be awarded for each division. Best of Show \$4; First Premium \$3; Second Premium \$2 and Third Premium \$1.
- J. Bring exhibits to the Home Arts Building on Sunday, July 2nd between 1:00 and 3:00 PM. Exception: All food must be dropped off on Monday, July 3rd, between 9:00 and 11:00 AM. Any items that are dropped off after 11:00 on Monday will not be judged and get a Participant ribbon only. Judging will be Monday July 3rd after 11:00 AM.
- K. All entries must be the result of this past year's work.
- L. Each item entered must have an exhibitors tag (available at Home Arts Building).
- M. All exhibits must be picked up at the fairgrounds between 1:00 and 3:00 PM, Sunday, July 9th. Items not picked up on Sunday will be available at the Fair Office on Monday, July 10th between 11:00 AM-1:00 PM.
- N. If there are less than 3 entries in a division, only First Premium will be awarded if the person has scored at least a 70 on their score sheet.
- O. All entries must be show quality to be eligible for an award.
